Update Autumn 2024

Our Heritage Centre has been open for 2 years, telling the story of Methodism's contribution to East Anglia over the last 250 years.

During both years we opened 2 days a week from spring to autumn and welcomed a steady stream of visitors from many parts of the UK and beyond, over 400 in 2023 and over 300, so far, in 2024.

We are regularly given items of Methodist historic interest to display and boxes of paper ephemera for our reference library, so much so that we have run out of space.

But we have a plan!

The Plan

The Circuit Trustees have given us permission to expand and North Norfolk District Council have granted us full planning permission to:

- Extend the library, doubling its size
- Convert the 1950s toilets into one wheelchair accessible toilet and a walk-in store.
